Monetary donations that are not specifically designated for one purpose will be used to fund the highest priorities as decided by the GMGA Board of Directors. Highest priorities are usually designated for GMGA scholarships, GMGA elementary school programs or operational financial needs. Additionally, unrestricted monetary donations allow the Board to combine these gifts with fundraising monies or other GMGA funds to satisfy more expensive needs.
